#### Sermon

Grace, mercy, and peace to you from God our Father, and from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, and from the Holy Spirit, who calls, gathers, enlightens, sanctifies, and keeps us in the one true faith, until that glorious reappearing of our great God and coming King, Jesus, the Christ! Amen!

In the Garden of Eden, the serpent tempted Adam and Eve with the knowledge of Good and Evil. They already knew good. They were part of God's perfect creation, in a perfect relationship with God. But they wanted to be like God. They wanted to be god. And so, sin entered the world corrupting God's perfect creation. God is a just God who must punish sin and evil. Yet even as God pronounces the curses that resulted from sin, God promised a redeemer to save mankind from sin. Throughout the Old Testament, God foreshadows Jesus our Redeemer and our redemption. God saves Israel throughout the Old Testament, pointing to Jesus, our Savior, in the New Testament. God foreshadows saving His people through David, who saves God's people from their enemies.

David wrote Psalm 24 possibly to celebrate the moving of the ark of the covenant into Jerusalem. A worship entry Psalm, the last four verses celebrate the King of Glory entering the city of David where the Temple will be built as God's dwelling among His people. This foreshadows Jesus's three comings. First, His Nativity, his being born of Mary. Second, Jesus comes to us in his Word and Sacraments. Third, Jesus will come again on the Last day to judge the living and the dead, as we just confessed.

We need to be rescued. Brokenness, destruction, disease, and death surround us. We add to the brokenness through our selfish ambitions, hatred of others, and self-centered greed. Genesis 6:6 tells us, "And Trinity Lutheran Church, Harvel, IL 5 Pastor Nehring

the LORD regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart". We cannot free ourselves from sin. We need Jesus. We His Salvation. Those around us need His Salvation. John 3:16 "16" For God so loved the world, [i] that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." God sent Jesus on a mission to save souls for all eternity. Jesus gave the Church that mission in Matthew 28:18-20 "18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

That's were LWML comes in. By collecting mites, leftover change, LWML funds mission projects around the world, \$2,350,000 worth. The ladies take small things like pocket change and turn it into \$2,350,000 of mission grants, partnerships to share Jesus's love with others. By serving God's church, these ladies are God's hands and feet to serve God and one another. These ladies support and encourage one another as they grow spiritually through devotions and bible studies.

The Law accuses. The Law convicts us that we can never be holy as God is holy. The Gospel is our only hope. The King of Glory comes in, with and through the Gospel. The Holy Spirit calls us to come to faith, be baptized and be born anew/again in Christ. 2 Cor. 5:17 "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." God provides us with grace to fight off every kind of evil. Through Word and Sacrament, God provides temporal and eternal means for receiving the King of Glory right now and into eternity. Romans 1:16-17 "The Gospel is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith". The Gospel is the life-changing message of God. It changed Martin Luther from one seeking to appease the wrath of God, by doing good works, to one who received the grace of God in Christ, and who brought the Gospel back to the Church.

The world has been in the throes of sin since the 'Fall.' Oftentimes we believe our times are the worst of times. Yes, we have seen horrific and horrible atrocities: wars, senseless killing of babies, children and adults; poverty, homelessness, addictions, every kind of evil one can imagine. Without Christ, these evils lead to hopelessness and despair, to giving up. With Christ, we have God's grace and mercy. We have found favor in the eyes of God for the sake of Jesus, our great Prophet, Priest and King. We find favor and grace in our King, Jesus, as we look beyond the brokenness to the blessed hope of His coming again.

Like King David, we look to a heavenly King. David knew the dark, sinful world, even in his own life and family. But David, a man after God's own heart (Acts 13:22), found hope from the darkness in the light of God's grace.

How do you respond to God's love, grace and mercy? You join in God's Mission. You tell others about Jesus and His impact on your life. You pray for others as Paul writes in 1 Timothy 2:1-7:

"First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Jesus Christ, who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time. For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

You show God's love for you in your day-to-day life. You support this church and organizations like LWML, a part of God's Mission

A little fearful girl, sleeping alone in the darkness of her room, cried out to mom and dad as a storm rolled across her Midwest-town. "Mom, dad, come in here," she cried in the dark of night, as the storm rolled and roared as if it was in the room with her. Mom and dad consoled her and reminded her that they were in the next room and God is in the room with her so she need not fear. They encouraged her to go back to sleep. Awakened

again and again by the rolling and roaring storm, she said to her parents the last time they entered her room, "I know you said God is in here with me, but I need someone in here with skin."

God shows you your sins through the Law. God shows you the sinful darkness of the world. God has given us Jesus, God in the flesh, God with skin.. God gives you His grace and love by the power of the Holy Spirit who keeps you and the whole church in the one true faith. Jesus suffered and died for your sins and the sins of the whole world. Rejoice and be glad. Be about God's Mission as the LWML is, sharing the good news of Jesus as you await His coming again and spending eternity with Him in His Kingdom. Amen.

May the peace of God which surpasses all understanding keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus to everlasting life. Amen.
